The LawCredit Process

1. Visit your law firm's secure payment page. There, you will notice a tab that says LawCredit.

2. Clicking this tab takes you to an online application for funding through PayPal Credit.

Yes, there may be a small impact since PayPal Credit will do a credit check as part of their evaluation process.

Who sets my interest rate? Why is it so high?

Interest rates are set by PayPal Credit based on your current credit score and history of credit payment.

How do I make payments to my attorney for this credit?

You will make payments to PayPal Credit and not your attorney.

Should I communicate with my lawyer if I have any issues or questions about this credit?

No, your attorney is not involved in the financing agreement. You should direct any questions to [PayPal Credit](#).

What if I don't receive enough credit to fund the transaction?

You will need to discuss this with your lawyer to see if they are open to a partial payment or an alternative arrangement.
